from the lane that goeth towards his
house from the Gages to find it through
his his land to the Country Road as it
goeth to andover and that Sd Daniel Gage
find a way from Sd ferry to the Country Road
at Capt Atwood Brick house and also
Sd lane that is between Nathaniel Gage and
and John Gage
that then the Towne Do Desire this ferry
may Be settled on sd Moses Day and on
sd Daniel Gage and thaier heirs forever
