Bradford may th^e 28th : 1747 we the Subcribers being appinted be th^e Seclet men of our town to Joyn with the Seclet men of andover or whom they Should appint to meet at John Peabodys in Andover the twenty Eighth of this Instant May to premlate the Line between Andover and our town and have agreed and Renued the old former bounds viz the piller of Stones at the pine hill and an heap of Stones in M^r Asgoods field and a heap of Stones at ward hill by th^e River
