Joseph Mullicken & John Baley were Chosen Corders of
wood and Sworn
Stephen Kimball was Chosen Sealer of Leather
David Wood John Carlton and Timothy Hardy were

voted that the widow Walenford be allowed her Rates
for the year 1748 that is her husbands head
voted that the Seclet men and over Seers of the
poor Shant order nor draw any money out of the
hands of the Town tresurer Except that which has
ben agreed on Legaly in a town meeting
