At a legal Towne meting of the freeholders and the inhabitance  
of the towne of Bradford helde march : 25 : 1698/9 then was chosen for constable  
for th<sup>e</sup> yeare ensuing samuel stickney juner : for selecte men was chosen Ensigne Joseph  
Baly for Corprill Richard Kimbell Richard Hall sen John Hardy sen and Richard Kimball jnr  
David Haseltine was chosen for towne Clerk for tything men was chosen Thomas  
west and William Huchins : for fence vewers was chosen Thomas kimbell and robert  
mulecom for serveires of high wayes was chosen phillep atwood and James  
palmer : to see to m<sup>r</sup> symmes ocations was chosen robert Haseltine Solomon wood  
abraham Haseltine was chosen to to reseve m<sup>r</sup> Symmes rate  
att the Same time it was voted that m<sup>r</sup> symmes Salery being Sixty pounds the ---  
halfe in wheat and pork the other halfe in other graine : Then it was voted  
that for the time to com one third of said Sixty pounds is to be payed  
in money and sd twenty pounds is to be abatied oute of the whete and pork
