

At a legal Towne meeting of the freeholders and other the Enhabitance of the towne of Bradford helde march : 4 : 1701 : Then was chosen for Towne Clerk for the yeare Ensuing David Haseltine : for constable was Chosen Robert Haseltine sener for select men was chosen Leut Samuell Stickne William Hardy sener : Sargent John Chadduk : Corprill Richard Kimball and John Huchings : for tythingmen was chosen Joseph palmer and Soloman wood for to seate the highways was chosen Richard Kimball and John wood for sirveiors of fences John Watson and Jonathan Kimball : to see to m<sup>r</sup> Symmes ocations was chosen Thomas Stick Robert mulecum To reseve m<sup>r</sup> Symmes rate was chosen Abraham Haseltine

It was notied that the selecte men has powere to give liberty to Richard Hall : Ichabad Boynton : Samuell Kimball : Richard haseltine and nathan Webster to Buld up a seate in the front gallery behind the third seat David Haseltine was chosen seler of Waights and meshurs voted that th<sup>e</sup> select men has full power to provide teching for the children of this towne to reade and write

At a leagal town meeting of the freeholders and other the Enhabitance of the towne of Bradford held march : 10 : 1702 Corprill Richard Kimbl was chosen constable for th<sup>e</sup> year ensuing Then also was chosen for select Robert Haseltine sen Richard Kimbl Thomas Kimbl : Samuel Tenny and Caleb Hopkison David Haseltine was chosen Towne Clerk Ensine Joseph Baly and John Boynton was chosen Tythingmen : Danell Gage Abraham Kimball : Danill Hardy : and William Stickney were Chosen Serveiors of higwayes and fence vieers to see to m<sup>r</sup> Symmes ocations was chosen Robert Mulecum and Thomas Stickney
