It was then voted and paused on the afauermtive that the Towne would fourthwith build a new meting house
It was then voted and granted that the metinghouse should be forty and tow feet in brenth and forty and Eight feet Long
Capt David haseltine and m^r John Chadwick and Eincine Joseph Baly ware choys of by the towne to make Inquire of workmen how Chepe or upon what terms they may have this metinghouse built and to make Reporte to the Town what the terms are that ane workmen do propose how they will build the same and to make Report to the Towne on the 17 day of this Instant December this meting which was on the 3 day of December 1705 was Adjourned till the forsaid 17 day of December

3 : it was then voted and paused on the afarmittive that the metinghouse that is voted to be builded when it is feet to Rayse Shaall Stand upon the Knowl on the Esteside of the old metinghouse within Eight Rods or so neare as shall be thought convinant

4 It was then voted and paused on the afarmittive that the Specsae to pay for this metinghouse which is voted to be builded Sall be one third part in Silver mony and the other 2 third partse Shall in Silver mony or in grayne as Silver

5 It was then voted and paused on the afarmittive that the first payment for the meting house shall be payed this next may which will be in the yeare : 1706 : and the 2^d payment shall be payed at the may com twelve month which will be in the yeare 1707 and the . 3 . and Last payment shall be payd the may following which will be in the yeare 1708

6 It was then voted and paused on the afarmittive that cap^t David haseltine and cornet Richard Kemball and John houchons should be a commity to bargin with carpenders or to pece course the meting house build : 7 : it was then voted and paused on the afarmittive that this Committy namly Cap^t David haseltine and cornet Richard Kimbell and John huchins shall have full and todall power to Despose of the Towns mony for the yeare afore Said
