payed in june foling

3 it was then voted and pased on the afermitive the Commity  
Commity that weare Chosen to Seate the new meting house  
Should goo by this Roul that is to Seate all the  
men that are above Sixty years old acording to there  
Eage and all the Rest of the towne acording to there Rates  
having no Respect to the heads of sons or Servants

Att a Ligall town meting of the freeholders and others the  
Inhabitants of the towne of bradford held January : 14 : 1709  
then voted and pased on the afermitive that the Reverent  
mr Symes Rate Shall be at one payment and that to do  
by the Last of January

2 It was then voted and pased on the afermitive that  
whereas the towne are indeted unto Insine Joseph baly  
and Left Richard Kemball and John houchins the suof one hundred and Sixty and Seven pounds and teen  
shelens

the Last payment being to be payed this next may  
now voted that the town wil haive this last payment  
For one yeare and what the Charg of haiving the aforesaid  
mony Shall amount unto the towne will Reim berse it

3 then voted that Corpl Robert haseltine and Thomas Kembl  
and Richard Kemball Junr Shall be a commity to  
Refere a deed of the house and Land of the fourmere commity  
namly Insine Joseph baly and Left Richard Kemball and  
John houchens which they bought of mr Symes heires  
and Fourthwith Give a deed of the whomstead to the Reverent  
mr Thomas Symes In the towns behalf
