ways when they are warned by the ovarsars shall pay
3 shillings four pens for 1 days defect in not appearing att
time and plas apioneted and soe proportionable after the rate of
3 shillings 4 pens a day for soe much as they Com
short of a days worke by Coming late or by not
continuing to worke the whole day.

Joseph Pike att

At a legall meeting of the select men Joseph
Pike was apointed to give notis to such as have done
worke about the ministers house whairby they may outset
it one thayr rates with the constable

At a legall towne meetting the second day of
march 68 Thomas Dow was agreed with to set up 40 rod
of fens on the ministars land by the midle of next
Aprill for which hee is to out fit the Indean Corn
yarde of his rates & for the rest he is to have it
in Indean Corne to the value of 4 pounds in
the whole which hee is to have for seting up the sd
fens he geting the stufe and bringing it into plase.
