of the towne : Robert mulecan was chosen Constabel for the yeare Ensuing for  
the Easte Ende of the towne : for select men was chosen Deakin hall  
Jonas plattes : Daniel Gage Richard Baly : and Richard Haseltine  
for Towne clerk was chosen Sargnt nathanil walker : for sirveirs of fences  
and highways : for th<sup>e</sup> west ende was chosen Sargnt John Boynton and Capt robert  
Haseltine : for the East end of the towne of the towne was chosen clerk hopkison : John wood  
for tythingmen was chosen : David Kimball : John Hall : Samuel kimbel

oure anuall towne meeting shall be helde on the second Tuesday of march  
and so to continue : voted that the perisheners be alowed to make seates pue  
fashen in the hind part of the west gallery : votied that 12 young wimene be  
alowed to make up the hinde seate in the Easte gallery puefashen and have it to sit in  
voted that Thom kimbel jun maxemilion haseltin : Jonathen chadwick with so  
many as they shal take in to the number of 12 to make a seate puesfashen in the  
hinde part of the present gallery : voted that thomas carlton and Jonathan woodman  
with such as they shal alow to Joyne with them has liberty to mak up the  
hind seate in the north Easte corner of the meeting pue fashen and there  
wives to have the benefit of sitting in the same : voted that goodman

Spoferd has liberty to sit in the forth sete Before the pulpit : and his wife to sit in the third sete in the northeast corner : the select men to give them notice
